## MIDDLEPORT FIRE DEPARTMENT MR. ED'S ATHLETIC CLUB ANNUAL SCHOLARSHIP AWARD

*Mr. Ed's Athletic Club* and the *Middleport Fire Department* will award scholarships this year to selected persons choosing to further their education and enter the field of public service. Examples include careers in Fire Service, EMS, Police, or the field of medicine.

Applicants for this award must meet the following criteria:

- Be a graduating Roy-Hart senior or a Roy-Hart graduate enrolled as a full-time college student carrying at least 12 credit hours;
- Be accepted or enrolled at an institute of higher education (i.e., college or university).
- Be enrolled in a curriculum which has relevance to the field of public service.

Applicants shall provide the following:

- A completed application form signed by the applicant;
- Copy of the letter of acceptance to an institute of higher learning (i.e., university or college).

Selection shall be made by a reviewing committee consisting of representatives of the Roy-Hart area emergency services and Mr. Ed's Athletic Club. The decision of the committee shall be final.

## Failure of an applicant to attend college in the fall semester following the awarding of the scholarship shall result in forfeiture of the award. Cash value of the award shall be returned to the Middleport Fire Company no later than September 30<sup>th</sup> of the year awarded.

Application material shall be received at the Roy-Hart High School Guidance Office or the Middleport Village Hall *no later than May 15, 2019*. Application materials shall be placed in an envelope marked "Middleport Fire Department/Mr. Ed's Scholarship Application."
