As used in Chapter 140 of the Code of the Village of Middleport, the following terms shall have the meanings indicated:

ESTABLISHED PLACE OF BUSINESS: a building or store in which the person transacts business and deals in the goods, wares, and merchandise he hawks, peddles, or solicits for during regular business hours.

HAWKER and PEDDLER: Except as hereinafter expressly provided, any person, either principal or agent, who, in any public street or public place or by going from house to house or place of business to place of business on foot or on or from any animal or vehicle standing in a street or highway, sells or barters, offers for sale or barter or carries or exposes for sale or barter any goods, wares, or merchandise, including magazines and other publications, except as hereinafter exempted.

PERSON: One or more persons, corporations, partnerships, associations, joint-stock companies, societies, and all other entities.

SOLICITOR: Any person who goes from place to place or house to house or who stands in any street or public place taking or offering to take orders for goods, wares or merchandise, except as hereinafter exempted, or for service to be performed in the future, or for making, manufacturing or repairing any article or thing whatsoever for future delivery.

- **§140-6**: Conviction by the applicant of a crime involving fraud, theft, assault, or any crime of violent or of moral turpitude shall be grounds for refusal.
- A license shall not be assignable.
- Any license issued shall automatically expire on January 1 following the date of issuance of such license, but such license may provide for an earlier expiration date corresponding to the termination of the activity.
