A special meeting of the Board of Trustees was held on Wednesday, March 3, 2021, in the Village Hall. Mayor Westcott opened the meeting at 1:05 p.m. Also present were Deputy Mayor Conley, Trustee Blumrick, Trustee McAvoy, Trustee Barr, Coordinator Bobbitt, Police Chief Swick, and Clerk-Treasurer VanBuren.

Clerk VanBuren asked the Board about the Niagara County by the Numbers – Mural Project as requested by Mike Weber. Discussion ensued about where a mural would be appropriate and who could be the custodian of the project. The Board decided that they are simply not interested at this time.

Discussed the changes to the budget that the Mayor and the Clerk-Treasurer had suggested in order to close the gap in the budget of the General Fund, Water Fund, and the Sewer Fund. The Board reviewed the expenditures in the General Fund to see if there were more cuts that could be made to reduce the budget further.

Clerk VanBuren presented the Board with the Village's multi-year comparison from the last five years from openbookny so that the Board could see the Village's Fiscal comparison report.

Clerk VanBuren presented information to the Board regarding possible tax levy and tax rates. Discussion ensued and the Board will approve the 2021-2022 Preliminary Revenues, Expenditures, and Wages as well as the Tax Levy and Tax Rate at the next Board meeting which is Monday, March 15, 2021.

There being no other business, a motion was made by Deputy Mayor Conley, and seconded by Trustee Blumrick, to adjourn the meeting at 2:44 pm.
